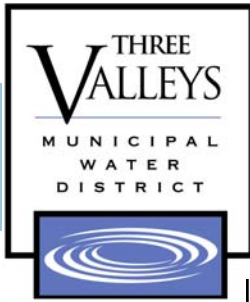

Since its formation, the Three Valleys Municipal Water District has installed some 37,000 feet of pipeline and delivered more than 175 billion gallons of water.
