## ***Three Valleys Municipal Water District Wins Top Outreach Award For The Region***

Claremont, California – Three Valleys Municipal Water District has been notified by the Association of California Water Agencies (ACWA) that it was selected as the top outreach winner in its region for 2021. ACWA is the largest statewide coalition of water agencies in the country, with more than 430 public agencies. Three Valleys Municipal Water District falls in ACWA’s Region 8, comprised of both Los Angeles and Ventura County. This marks the thirteenth year that Three Valleys has been honored by ACWA with this award.

Outreach winners are recognized for their efforts in responding to key legislative issues and making quality contacts with congress members, state assembly members and senators on water legislation throughout California. Three Valleys was active during the year in support of favorable teleconferencing legislation and the acquisition of COVID relief funding for water agencies and special districts.

ACWA will acknowledge the achievement of Three Valleys Municipal Water District at the 2021 ACWA Fall Conference on Thursday, December 2<sup>nd</sup> in Pasadena.

*In 1950, Pomona Valley Municipal Water District (PVMWD) was formed under State law for the purpose of annexing to the Metropolitan Water District (MWD), thereby entitling the area to receive water imported to the region. The District changed its name to Three Valleys Municipal Water District in 1981.*

*TVMWD, a water resources management agency is governed by an elected Board of seven officials and covers approximately 133 square miles. The current population is about 515,000. Since its formation the Three Valleys Municipal Water District has installed some 37,000 feet of pipeline and delivered more than 150 billion gallons of water.*
